

## 133 Countries Mexicans Can Travel To Without Visa



Mexican passports may actually have a lot more value than what you accord it at the moment.

According to the most recent global index of international passports, citizens of Mexico had visa-free access or visa on arrival access to over 130 countries and territories. This ranks the Mexican passport 23rd in the world among countries with the highest number of access to other countries and territories visa-free or with visa issuance on arrival. What this means is that you wouldn't need to apply for visa to travel to any of the countries listed below; simply pack your bags and take off and you could stay up to the stipulated length of days.

However, it is necessary that you verify with the embassy of the country you are planning on travelling to very close to the time of your travel because visa requirements change frequently. Below is a list of countries where Mexico nationals with Mexican passports are not required to secure a visa to visit.

On this page, you would find more countries where citizens of Mexico can travel to without prior visa arrangement so long as they have their Mexican passport and later down on the page, you would find the list of countries that would issue visa to Mexicans on arrival. This means that you would still not need to make any arrangements before travel and in some cases, you may be required to show your return or ticket and demonstrate that you have enough funds to cover for your stay. Typically, most countries would require that passports have at least 6 months validity to gain entry. Extensions of stay are usually granted upon payment of visa extension fee. It is also important that you please check with your respective embassies prior to travel as visa policies and requirements change often.
